◇ Providence Creek Academy Summer Camp is a weekly day camp that provides full days of social interaction which build socializing skills, physical activity, reading/educational concentrated activities, and goal building skills. Sign-ups are done every week for nine weeks and camper spots are open throughout the summer.

#### **Camp Days:**

<b>1:30-3:30pm</b>	<u>Afternoon block</u> - Hiking trail, games, creative activities, team building, free play, arts-n-crafts

<b>4:00-6:00pm</b>	<u>After care</u> - Pick up, sign-out, care included in cost

◇ Certain days are subject to change (ex: Water Fun Days, Cook-outs, Field trips, Guest Speakers). Field trips will include Killen's Pond, Xbos, Dover Mall Movie Theater, Parks, and Vitale's Water Ice

**What to Bring:** All campers are expected to bring a pair of sneakers, a book to read, and a lunch everyday unless directed otherwise. Sunscreen, inhalers, and a water bottle are also highly recommended.

**What's Included:** Campers will be exposed to a 7:1 camper/counselor ratio that guarantees constant caretaking and facilitation at all times. All campers will receive a camp T-shirt, personalized water bottle, a basket for personal belongings, along with many other incentives/arts-n-crafts.

**Costs:**

- ◆ The cost for an entire 5-day week is **\$95**.
- ◆ Additional siblings will receive \$20 off weekly payments (Ex: 2 children =170 a week).
- ◆ All other adjustments must be handled with the camp coordinator.
- ◆ Field trip fees may be added

**\*\*Upon Registration, \$50 is due as a deposit**  
(Remainder of first week payment will be due on first day of camp)
