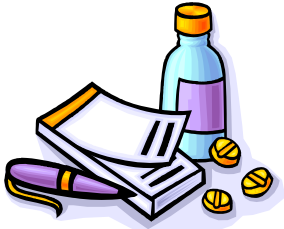

**TO ALL PARENTS & GUARDIANS:**

**The nurse's office has been depleted all of its funds for school year 2008-2009. Due to ongoing need for over the counter medication we has not been able to keep up with the demand for pain/fever relief, Tums, cough syrup, and cough drops for students. We use an average of 3-4 bottles of Children's Tylenol/Motrin on a weekly basis.**

**We have requested donations ongoing throughout the year and a small amount of parents have donated. To those parents I can not thank you enough! Unfortunately, neither previous donations nor our small budget can keep up with the demand of our ill students without the help of additional supplies at this time.**

**If you could be so kind to donate any of the above items it would be greatly appreciated. Generic brands are encouraged and welcome. They must be unopened and sealed. We do have a policy of not allowing children to transport medications to school per state regulations. Administration has made special accommodations with our outside morning staff to be able to accept these donations as you drop your child off for school. You can also hand them to your child's bus driver for adult transportation to the nurse's office for your convenience.**

**Having these requested over the counter medications helps keep your child in school and eliminates missed time from work for parents and guardians. To date we have 1/2 a bottle of Child's Motrin that we are saving for emergency situations only. This means unless we receive donations, if your child has a headache, muscle pain, low grade fever, sore throat, or GI upset, he or she will not be administered medication. We will no choice but to call parents/guardians to pick up students if he or she can not physically be maintained in class.**
