Dear Parents/Guardians:

As you may be aware, the residences of a portion of our student population may be affected in the event of a problem at the Salem/Hope Creek Nuclear Generating Stations (SHCNGS). While it is highly unlikely that a plant condition would warrant protective actions, it is wise that our residents be trained and prepared.

The state, county, and local municipality have combined resources to prepare a detailed plan for any emergency – this message is part of a public education program to acquaint you with details, which affect your school children who reside in the 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ), but attend schools outside the 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ).

In the event of an emergency, the first action would be to retain students at their school until your arrival to pick him/her up. If the plant conditions are projected to worsen, your children would still be instructed to remain at school as they would not be permitted to enter back into the Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ).

Your child is registered in the Providence Creek Academy Charter School and will remain at his/her school and be cared for until your arrival to pick him/her up and reunite with the family. Buses will not transport students to their homes in the event of an emergency at Salem/Hope Creek.
